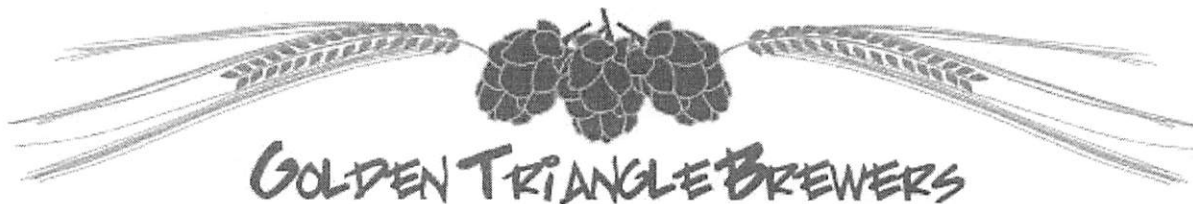


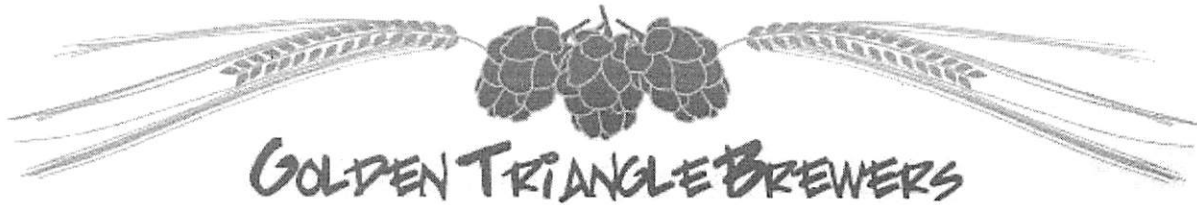
# June 6, 2012

The homebrew clubs and brewers are staying at the Days Inn Pensacola Beachfront. Rooms facing the road are \$109 and facing the beach they are \$129. It is recommended that you get a room facing the road because it will be very noisy facing the beach. Thursday night is a beer pairing dinner that most of our club doesn't go to. Friday is the big festival. Saturday is the beach party. Club members can get admittance to the festival for \$15 is paid for in advance through the club.
